RAIL SERVICE

The NJ Transit Rail Terminal is conveniently located within the Convention Center and connects Atlantic City to Philadelphia at 30th Street Station and Amtrak's Northeast corridor lines. Trains run on the hour. Estimated cost from Philadelphia to Atlantic City is \$23.00 per person for a round trip. (prices subject to change).

The Septa High Speed Rail Line train (www.septa.org) runs from the Philadelphia International Airport to 30th Street Station. Estimated fare is \$6.00.



AIR SERVICE

Free shuttle service runs according to train arrival and departure times. Please check the train schedules.
